Wampum, and Darlington and on to the PA/OH State Line on St. Rt. 251, outside of Negley, OH, as shown on the map inside.



Beaver & Lawrence Counties of PA


This National Scenic Trail covers 4,600 miles across seven states. The National Park Service administers the Trail.
